The international superstar Eros Ramazzotti brings the Ischgl skiing season to a close with the legendary "Top of the Mountain Closing Concert". Eros Ramazzotti: Italy on the tongue

With 16 studio albums, some 150 platinum awards and more than 50 million albums sold globally, Eros Ramazzotti is one of Italy's most popular and successful artists. The native Roman, born in October 1963, celebrated his first international success across Europe in 1986: His studio album "Nuovi eroi" climbed to the top of the charts in Italy, Austria and Switzerland and achieved gold status in Germany. In 2011, the multiple ECHO-award winner received the "Golden Camera" in the category "Best Music Internationally". Ramazzotti has sung with music greats such as Tina Turner, Joe Cocker, Anastacia, Ricky Martin or Helene Fischer. Beside his music, the 56-year-old is an avid footballer. As a member of the football team "Nazionale Italiana Cantanti", in which Italian singers play for a good cause, he has already participated in 222 tournaments and scored 127 goals.
