Varied descents, wonderful winter hiking trails and snowshoe tours as well as ten certified natural toboggan runs, which are prepared and sometimes illuminated at night, promise fun for the whole family. In addition, further highlights will be offered around the winter holidays with the carnival festival at the BIG Family Ski Center Schlick 2000 and the BIG FAMILY Action Days from February 26 to 27 at the Stubai Glacier.

In addition to perfect winter sports conditions until spring, the Stubai Valley, which is only a 20-minute drive from Innsbruck, also scores with its all-round carefree package. Book from the comfort of your home and buy the ski pass via the websites of the winter sports areas, travel stress-free by train, have yourself chauffeured directly and free of charge to your accommodation and shortly afterwards be equipped with the latest top equipment in the ski rental. In short: the perfect start for fun in the snow. On the destination side [www.stubai.at](http://www.stubai.at) many attractive **package deals** including accommodation and ski pass are waiting for you. They are thematically tailored to the season, the ski resorts, the needs of families and selected event highlights.

### **Excellent transport links: By train and bus directly to the hotel**

The package “**Nightjet to the snow**” will be available until 07 May and is a convenient, safe and also ecological solution for a holiday trip to the Stubai Valley. This combination ticket includes the train ride on the ÖBB Nightjet, which runs between Amsterdam, Düsseldorf, Hamburg and Vienna to Innsbruck, as well as the seat reservation and the ski pass for three to six days. Arriving in Innsbruck, the transfer service to your booked hotel in the Stubai Valley is waiting for the train travellers. For all guests, the tourism association also offers a free arrival and departure voucher from Innsbruck to the valley and back again. This includes the one-time use of the Stubai bus or the Stubaitalbahnhof railway.

Arriving at the hotel, your holiday can actually start immediately. Now only the right ski equipment is missing. Stubai would not be Stubai if holidaymakers could not comfortably borrow them directly on site. Owners of the ÖBB Nightjet Kombiticket receive a ten percent discount on ski rental at the Stubai Glacier and in the Schlick 2000. With the latest models in optimally prepared condition, it is not only more fun, you also travel more safely.
