

WELL-BEDDED IN TIROL: NEW ACCOMMODATION IN SUMMER 2023

Tirol's accommodation providers have once again come up with a wealth of new ideas to welcome their guests with innovative concepts and creative ideas in summer 2023 - whether in historical ambience, a luxurious SkyLoft, triangular timber house or a stylish jungle hotel in the middle of the mountains. Here, an overview of newly built and freshly renovated accommodation in Tirol:

Refined luxury: Nova Moments, Achensee

Nova Moments in Pertisau at Lake Achensee opens this summer with a mix of classic architecture and modern design, a wellness area with large glass fronts and panorama saunas, as well as an infinity whirlpool and view of the Rofan Mountains, contemporary rooms and suites with natural materials featuring wood and linen, as well as a restaurant with a stone pine clad dining lounge. Exclusive vantage point: Achensee SkyLoft at Hotel Rieser, Lake Achensee

The new Achensee SkyLoft at Hotel *Das Rieser* is not just the only hotel suite in Tirol with a private pool, but also offers an array of interior features, where natural materials combine with modern design. Two bedrooms and a children's room with en-suite bathrooms, a living room with open kitchen and sofa landscape ensure maximum comfort for two to six people. Charmingly casual: Wagnerhof, Achensee

The Wagnerhof in Pertisau on Lake Achensee is located just a few metres from the lakeshore and will be inviting guests to the new suite retreat in summer 2023, after major conversion and extension works. The luxurious suites - with either mountain or lake views - are furnished to superior standards and can comfortably accommodate two to four persons with up to 72 m2 of space. Stays are rounded off by regional, Austrian cuisine with ingredients from the hotel's own farm, as well as the new "Still & heimlich" spa with infinity pool, indoor and outdoor pool, sauna world, fitness room, quiet comfort zones and a spacious garden.

Relaxing time-out: Zeit.Glück Apartments, Alpbachtal

Stephanie Bühler took over the former *Prosserhof Guesthouse* in Radfeld in the Alpbachtal holiday region from her aunt. It took only 13 months to convert the house into eight new apartments with sauna, relaxation and fitness room as well as a roof terrace with views of the ancient Rattenberg Schlossberg Castle. *Zeit.Glück Appartements* offer space for two to six persons, are fully equipped and disabled friendly.

Historic ambience: Boutiquehotel Rattenberg, Alpbachtal

The new *Boutiquehotel Rattenberg* is ensconced in the middle of the historic old town of Rattenberg, Austria's smallest town. Authentic apartments: Greidlhof, Zillertal
