Sustainable into the future

Managing Director Lukas Pittl proudly explains: "The sustainable aspects of the new building include the reuse and reinstallation of the demolition material due to the good old building fabric, the use of sustainable timber construction and the installation of a PV system next spring with an annual energy production of 120,000 kWh, which corresponds to an emission saving of 48 tons of CO₂, or the equivalent of the number of 3,000 trees planted."
