From 31 March to 04 April 2025, the Electric Mountain Festival (EMF) will set the pace at the Heartbeat of the Alps. With superstars like Martin Garrix, Steve Aoki, and other international top DJs, the EMF promises five days full of music highlights against a stunning mountain backdrop—combined with great skiing.

In its more than ten-year history, the EMF has established itself as a true must-visit for electronic dance music fans. Tens of thousands of visitors travel to Sölden to party alongside international top acts at an altitude of over 2,000 meters in the heart of the ski area. addition to the XXL main stage at Giggijoch beyond 2,000 meters above sea level, countless

side event locations throughout the ski area ensure a multi-faceted festival program from

Monday to Wednesday. Locations include the FALCON Restaurant at the middle station

of Gaislachkogl, sun-kissed Heide Alm on ski piste no. 2, Philipp Sölden, Annemarie's

Hühnersteign, Panorama Alm and the exclusive ice Q restaurant at the summit of

Gaislachkogl. Several after-show parties round off the day. For the first time, the EMF will

end on Saturday with official closing parties at the cult venues Philipp Sölden and

Panorama Alm. These truly unique locations offer festival fans the great chance to enjoy

electronic dance music in different settings, combined with perfect slope conditions. From
